

## Dual meet scheduling model

Week 1	1/2	3/4	5/6
Week 2	2/3	4/5	6/1
Week 3	3/5	4/1	2/6
Week 4	4/2	3/6	1/5
Week 5	5/2	1/3	4/6

- Assign each team a number.
- In a 6 team division with 3 prelims, there are 15 dual meets, 3 prelims and 1 championship meet
- 19 meets divided by 6 teams equals 3 home meets per team with one team volunteering for a fourth home meet.
- Home meets can be a dual meet, a prelim or a championship meet.
- Review which teams are interested in hosting a prelim and championship meet, because these teams will host only 2 dual meets.
- Review each week and decide which team is the host and which team is the guest. Circle the host team.
- An entire week can be exchanged for another if there is a conflict in scheduling.
- Assign the prelim and championship meet locations.
